Overall Bill Pay Market Size (in billions)

While the total market size for U.S. household bills is \$3.87 trillion per year, this report focuses on the ten most common household bills, which amount to \$3.22 trillion. These include Mortgage; Rent; Auto Loan; Utilities (electric, gas, water & sewer, and waste & recycling); Auto Insurance; Cable & Internet & Phone; Health Insurance; Mobile Phone; Alarm & Security; and Life Insurance.



U.S. Households spend **\$3.22** Trillion annually on the ten most common household bills.

Bill Pay State Breakdown

Monthly Average Cost of the 10 Most Common Household Bills by State

Hawaiians spend \$3,070 each month on the ten most common household bills, 50% above the national average. At the other end of the spectrum, households in West Virginia average monthly bill payments of \$1,530 across the top ten categories, 25.2% below the average nationwide. The most expensive and least expensive states are illustrated below.
